Teacher Instructions

Read the words in **bold** out loud to your learner.



Today, you will learn about a new sound. Sometimes, two letters work together to make one sound.
(point to *ch*)

These two letters, *c* and *h*, work together to make the sound *ch*.

You hear the *ch* sound at the beginning of the word *chocolate*.

Say the word *chocolate*. What sound do you hear at the beginning? (*pause for the child to answer*)

That's right! *Ch* makes the *ch* sound.

Say the *ch* sound three times: *ch, ch, ch* (point to the *ch* each time)
