Teacher Instructions

Read the words in **bold** out loud to your learner.



Sometimes, letters work together to make one sound.

(point to *ar*)

You've already learned one sound that *ar* makes. In these words *ar* makes a different sound.

These two letters, *a* and *r*, work together to make the sound *or*.

You hear the *or* sound at the end of the word *war*.

Say the word *war*. What sound do you hear at the end? (pause for the child to answer)

That's right! *AR* makes the *or* sound.

Say the *AR* sound three times: *or, or, or* (point to the *ar* each time)



Practice reading these words. Point to each word as you read it.
