

Lesson 47

Teacher Instructions

Read the words in **bold** out loud to your learner.



Today, you will learn about new sounds. Sometimes, letters work together to make one sound.

(point to *sk*)

These two letters, *s* and *k*, work together to make the sound *sk*.

You hear the *sk* sound at the end of the word *ask*.

Say the word *ask*. What sound do you hear at the end? (*pause for the child to answer*)

That's right! *Sk* makes the *sk* sound.

Say the *sk* sound three times: *sk, sk, sk* (point to the *sk* each time)

(point to *sp*)

These two letters, *s* and *p*, work together to make the sound *sp*.

You hear the *sp* sound at the end of the word *gasp*.

Say the word *gasp*. What sound do you hear at the end? (*pause for the child to answer*)

That's right! *Sp* makes the *sp* sound.

Say the *sp* sound three times: *sp, sp, sp* (point to the *sp* each time)

(point to *st*)

These two letters, *s* and *t*, work together to make the sound *st*.

You hear the *st* sound at the end of the word *rust*.

Say the word *rust*. What sound do you hear at the end? (*pause for the child to answer*)

That's right! *St* makes the *st* sound.

Say the *st* sound three times: *st, st, st* (point to the *st* each time)
