Teacher Instructions

Read the words in **bold** out loud to your learner.



(point to oa) These letters, o and a, work together to make the sound oa.

You hear the oa sound at the beginning of the word oak. Say the oa sound three times: oa, oa, oa (point to the oa each time)

(point to ow) These letters, o and w, work together to make the sound ow.


You hear the ow sound at the end of the word snow. Say the ow sound three times: ow, ow, ow (point to the ow each time)

(point to old) These letters, o, l, and d, work together to make the sound old.

You hear the *old* sound at the end of the word *bold*. Say the *old* sound three times: *old*, *old*, *old* (point to the *old* each time)
