Sometimes when working together ***ue*** and ***ui*** make a similar sound. It's the sound at the end of the word ***due*** and the sound in the middle of the word ***fruit***.



Practice reading these words. Point to each word as you read it.



Now we are going to learn another way ***u*** can sound.

Sometime when there is a silent ***e*** at the end of a word with an ***u*** in the middle, the ***u*** makes the sound of its name ***U***, like the first sound in the middle of the word ***cube***.
